Making Smoothies

On January 3, 2017 we were excited to have invited Aaliyah's dad (Kevin) to the classroom to show the children how to use a blender to make fruit smoothies out of frozen fruit. The Butterfly teachers split the children into three small groups. Then Kevin introduced the ingredients to the children and explained how to blend all the ingredients together. In the process of making the fruit smoothies, Kevin chose different children to assist him by using a plastic spoon to scoop frozen fruit from the packages and chose another friend to hit the button on the blender to blend the fruit and juice together. Lastly, the children each received a cup of the fruit smoothie to try.

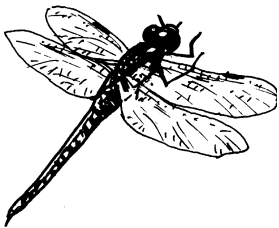
The children learned many new things through this activity including:

- Turn taking skills-Adding fruit to the blender one at a time
- Fine motor skills-Scooping the fruit using a small plastic spoon
- Sensory exploration-Tasting, touching, and smelling the smoothies
- New vocabulary for the various fruits
- How using a blender was faster to cut up fruit than their previous experience cutting up fruit manually for their fruit salads.

Making Pinatas

In January the Dragonflies made piñatas! To begin this activity we blew a balloon for every child to work with. Then Rhyan's parents (Aunty Karen and Uncle Johnny) brought in homemade glue for the children to use to glue strips of paper onto the balloons. After they finished gluing the strips of paper onto the balloons, the teachers set all the wet balloons on the counter of the display window to dry. Once dry, Teacher Anna set out some paint and brushes for the children to paint their own balloons. We then set the colorful balloons aside to dry before the children could take them home.

From this activity, the children learned to work carefully with the paper mache, newspaper, and balloons. They had to dip the strips of newspaper into the special glue and used two fingers to slide the extra glue down from top to bottom. They then had to make sure they were applying the strips of newspaper smoothly with no bumps. They also learned about how some of our friends fill piñatas with special goodies which are released when hit, and they learned two new vocabulary words: smooth and bumpy.
