and remember that the classroom bathrooms are for children only. If adults need to use the restroom please pick up a key at the front desk.

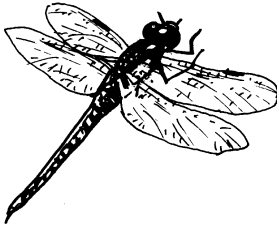

Baby Project Field Study to Target

In February the whole class went to Target on a field study to explore the baby department and to find some of the baby products that they have seen in our school classroom environment. The children then drew a picture of an object of their choice to bring back to school for further discussion.

From this field trip the children used their observational skills to draw their observational drawings. Many of the children drew pictures that looked almost exactly like the actual object. After they finished their drawing the children were able to walk around the Baby Department to discover other baby objects. Some of the children observed that some baby pants are longer and some are shorter. Some children also noticed that some of the baby outfits had snaps on the bottom. Teacher Anna then introduced the word "onesie" to the children and many of them practiced saying the word out loud together.

Making Strawberry Jam Sandwiches

In February the Butterflies made heart shaped strawberry jam sandwiches during their small group time. First, the children chose white or wheat bread for their

sandwiches. Next, they placed either a heart-shaped cookie cutter on top of the bread or used a plastic knife to trace around a piece of heart shaped cardboard placed on the bread. Next, they used the knife to scoop and spread strawberry jam onto the bread. Finally, they used a piece of bread without jam to cover the jam to make a sandwich!

Through this activity, the children were introduced to the following new vocabulary words: wheat, spread, tap. They also used their fine motor skills to cut the bread around the cookie cutter and to carefully scoop and spread the jam onto the bread. In addition, they practiced their turn-taking skills, hand-eye coordination, and used their senses to enjoy the activity together.
